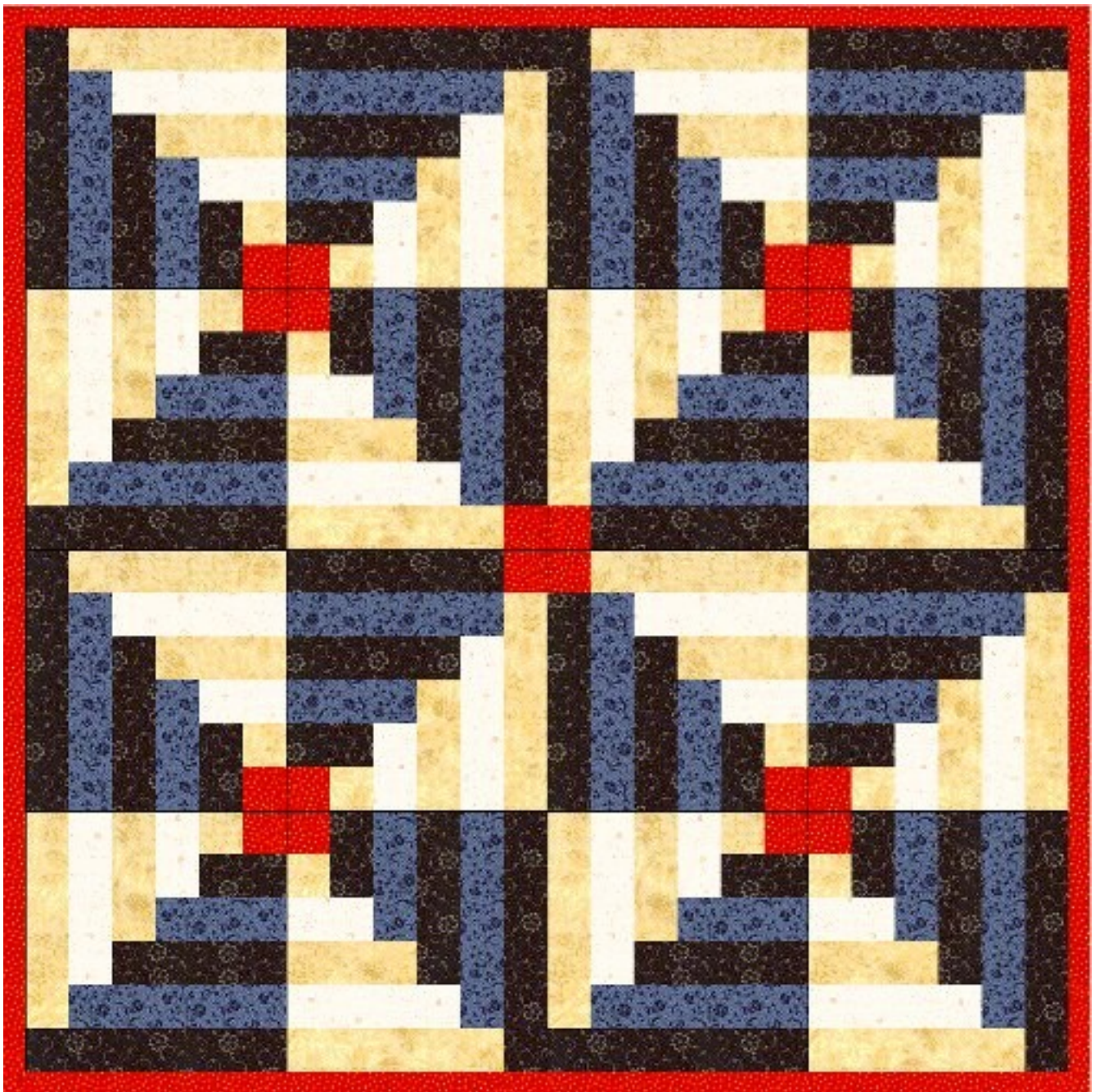


True Blue Quilt Pattern

Fabric Requirements:

1 ½ yards of dark blue fabric

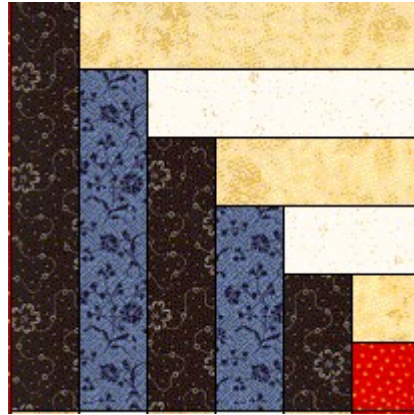
1 yard of medium blue fabric

1 ½ yards of red fabric

1 ¼ yards of tan fabric

¾ of a yard of cream fabric

Block 1:



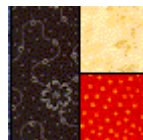
Make 12 of these blocks.

For one block you will need:

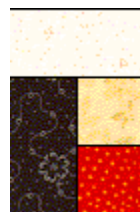
- 1 red 2 ½ inch square
- 1 tan 2 ½ inch square
- 1 dark blue 2 ½ x 4 ½ inch strip
- 1 cream 2 ½ x 4 ½ inch strip
- 1 medium blue 2 ½ x 6 ½ inch strip
- 1 tan 2 ½ x 6 ½ inch strip
- 1 dark blue 2 ½ x 8 ½ inch strip
- 1 cream 2 ½ x 8 ½ inch strip
- 1 medium blue 2 ½ x 10 ½ inch strip
- 1 tan 2 ½ x 10 ½ inch strip
- 1 dark blue 2 ½ x 12 ½ inch strip



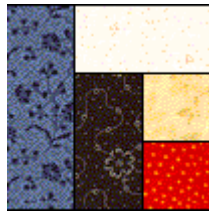
Sew the red 2 ½ inch square and the tan 2 ½ inch square together. Iron the seam towards the red fabric. (Always iron the seam towards the dark side.)



Sew the 2 ½ x 4 ½ inch dark blue strip on the left side.



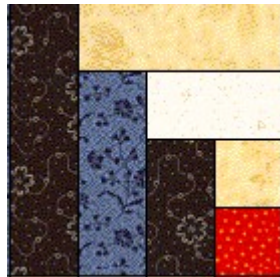
Sew the 2 ½ inch x 4 ½ inch cream strip to the top.



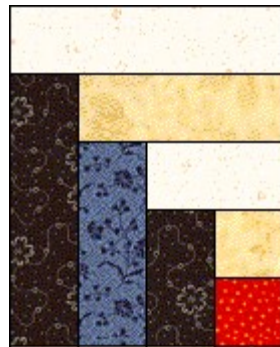
Sew the $2\frac{1}{2} \times 6\frac{1}{2}$ inch medium blue strip to the left.



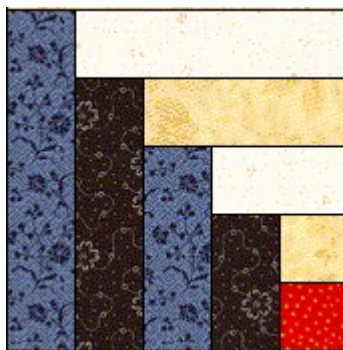
Sew the tan $2\frac{1}{2} \times 6\frac{1}{2}$ inch tan strip to the top.



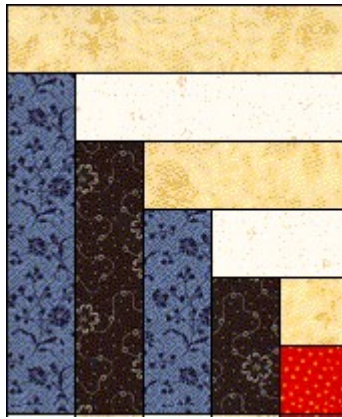
Sew the dark blue $2\frac{1}{2} \times 8\frac{1}{2}$ inch strip to the left.



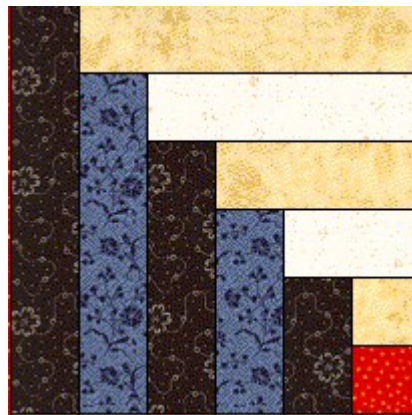
Sew the cream $2\frac{1}{2} \times 8\frac{1}{2}$ inch strip to the top.



Sew the medium blue $2\frac{1}{2} \times 10\frac{1}{2}$ inch strip to the left.

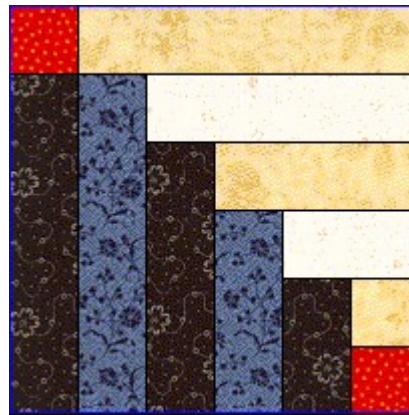


Sew the tan $2\frac{1}{2} \times 10\frac{1}{2}$ inch strip to the top.



Sew the dark blue $2\frac{1}{2} \times 12\frac{1}{2}$ inch strip to the left. Your block should measure $12\frac{1}{2}$ inches square.

BLOCK 2:

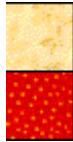


Make 4 of these blocks.

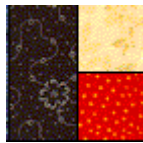
For one block you will need:

- 2 red $2\frac{1}{2}$ inch square
- 1 tan $2\frac{1}{2}$ inch square
- 1 dark blue $2\frac{1}{2} \times 4\frac{1}{2}$ inch strip
- 1 cream $2\frac{1}{2} \times 4\frac{1}{2}$ inch strip
- 1 medium blue $2\frac{1}{2} \times 6\frac{1}{2}$ inch strip

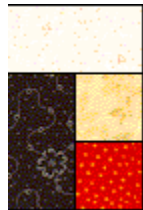
- 1 tan 2 ½ x 6 ½ inch strip
- 1 dark blue 2 ½ x 8 ½ inch strip
- 1 cream 2 ½ x 8 ½ inch strip
- 1 medium blue 2 ½ x 10 ½ inch strip
- 1 tan 2 ½ x 10 ½ inch strip
- 1 dark blue 2 ½ x 10 ½ inch strip



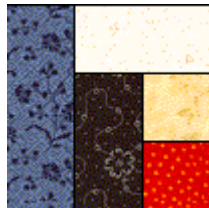
Sew the red 2 ½ inch square and the tan 2 ½ inch square together. Iron the seam towards the red fabric. (Always iron the seam towards the dark side.)



Sew the 2 ½ x 4 ½ inch dark blue strip on the left side.



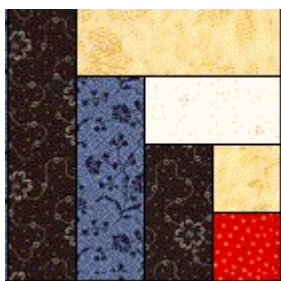
Sew the 2 ½ inch x 4 ½ inch cream strip to the top.



Sew the 2 ½ x 6 ½ inch medium blue strip to the left.



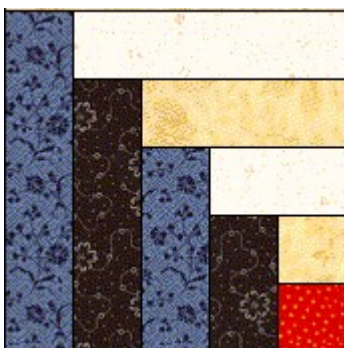
Sew the tan 2 ½ x 6 ½ inch tan strip to the top.



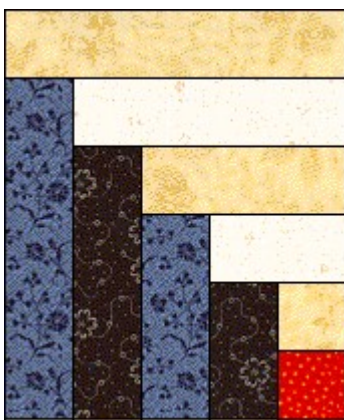
Sew the dark blue $2\frac{1}{2} \times 8\frac{1}{2}$ inch strip to the left.



Sew the cream $2\frac{1}{2} \times 8\frac{1}{2}$ inch strip to the top.



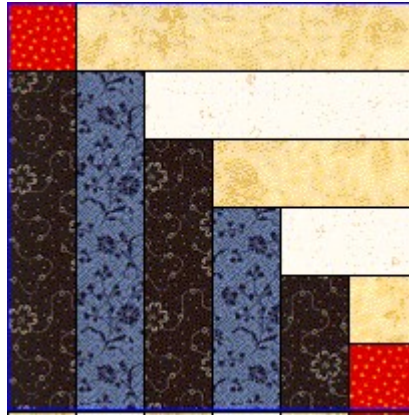
Sew the medium blue $2\frac{1}{2} \times 10\frac{1}{2}$ inch strip to the left.



Sew the tan $2\frac{1}{2} \times 10\frac{1}{2}$ inch strip to the top.

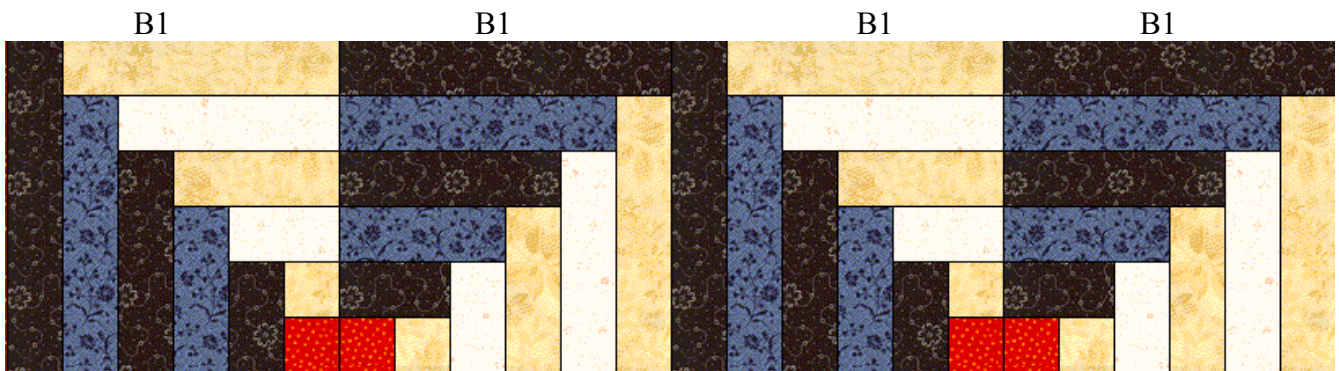


Sew the 2 ½ inch red square to the 2 ½ inch x 10 ½ inch dark blue strip. Sew this strip to the left of the block.

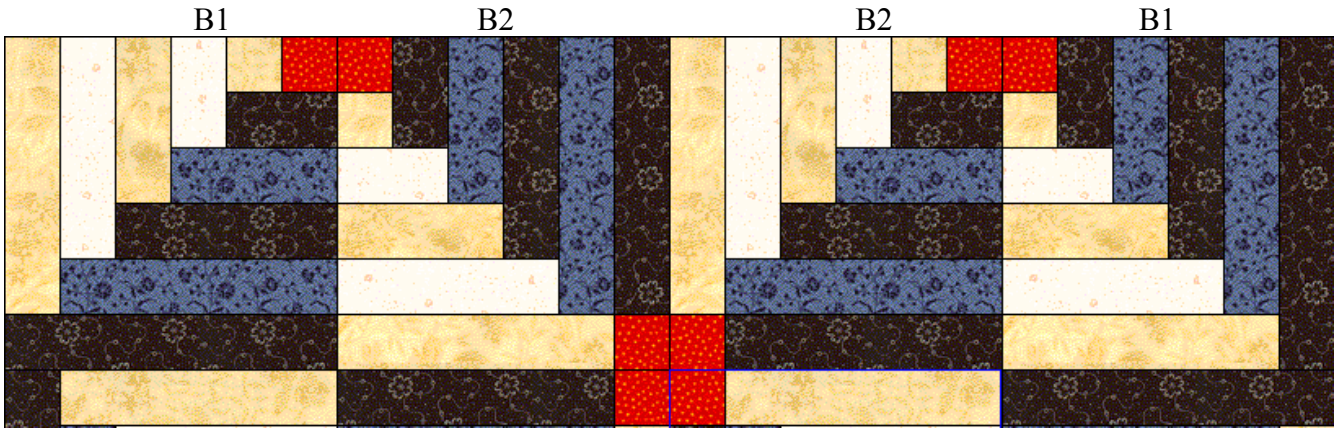


Here is how to sew them in rows.

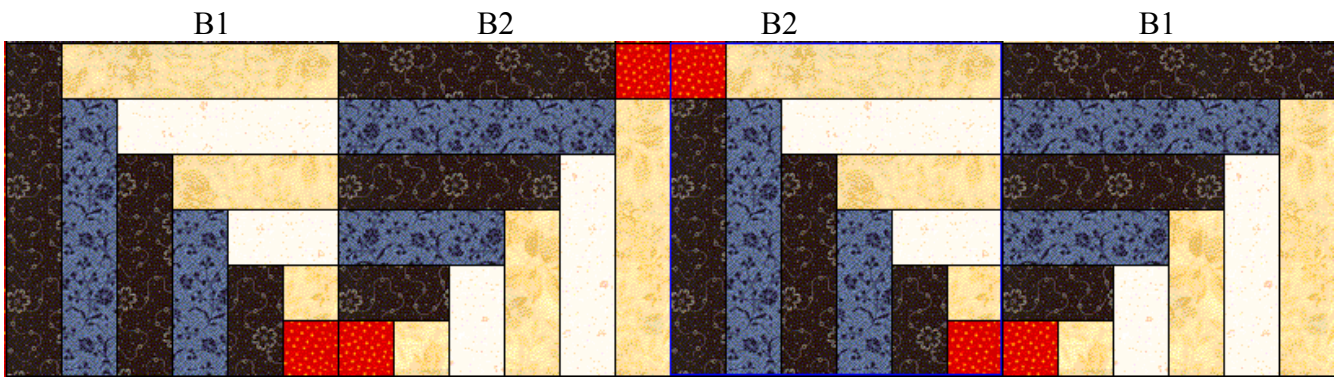
