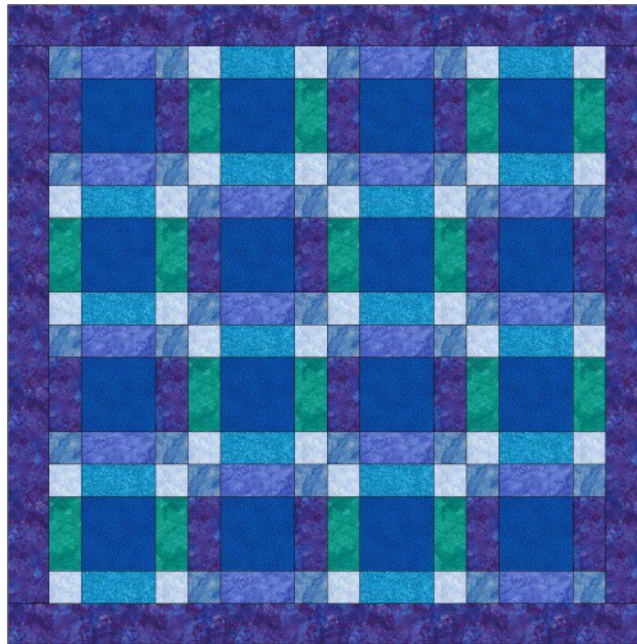


Blue Charm Quilt Pattern

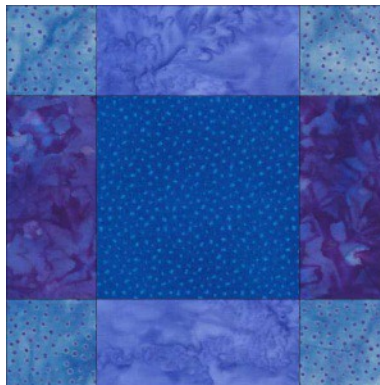
Finished Size 39 x 39 inches

Fabric Requirements:

- 16 Medium blue 5 inch squares ( $\frac{1}{2}$  a yard)
- 16 Navy blue 2  $\frac{1}{2}$  x 5 inch strips ( $\frac{1}{4}$  a yard) = (Eight 5 inch squares cut in half)
- 16 Light blue 2  $\frac{1}{2}$  x 5 inch strips ( $\frac{1}{4}$  a yard) = (Eight 5 inch squares cut in half)
- 32 Light blue 2  $\frac{1}{2}$  inch squares ( $\frac{1}{4}$  a yard) = (Eight 5 inch squares cut into 2  $\frac{1}{2}$  inch squares)
- 16 Blueish green 2  $\frac{1}{2}$  x 5 inch strips ( $\frac{1}{4}$  a yard) = (Eight 5 inch squares cut in half)
- 16 Teal 2  $\frac{1}{2}$  x 5 inch strips ( $\frac{1}{4}$  a yard) = (Eight 5 inch squares cut in half)
- 32 Very light blue 2  $\frac{1}{2}$  inch squares ( $\frac{1}{4}$  a yard) = (Eight 5 inch squares cut into 2  $\frac{1}{2}$  inch squares)
- Medium blue fabric cut into 3 inch strips ( $\frac{3}{4}$  a yard)

You will need to make 8 of quilt block 1 and 8 of quilt block 2.

Block 1

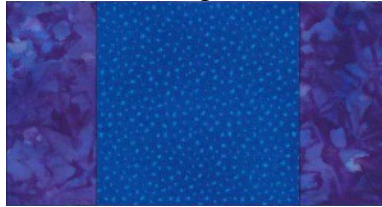


Strip 1



Using a  $\frac{1}{4}$  inch seam allowance sew a  $2\frac{1}{2}$  inch square of light blue fabric to each end of the  $2\frac{1}{2}$  x 5 inch light blue strip. Make 2 of these strips for each block.

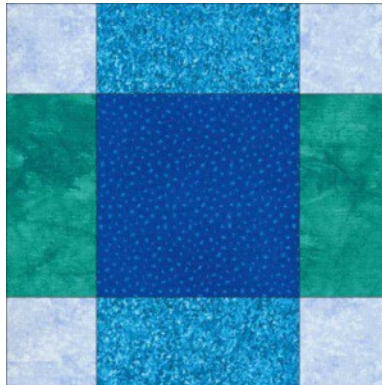
Strip 2



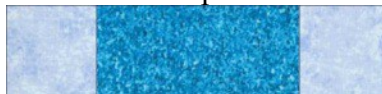
Sew a  $2\frac{1}{2}$  x 5 inch navy blue strip to each end of the 5 inch medium blue square. Make sure to iron your piece so the the seams lay flat. I iron my seams to the dark side. Some quilters iron them open. It really is up to you which way you want to iron the seam.

Sew strip 1 to the top and bottom of strip 2 to get one finished block. Make eight of these blocks.

Block 2

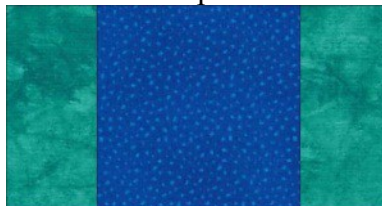


Strip 3



Using a  $\frac{1}{4}$  inch seam allowance sew a  $2\frac{1}{2}$  inch square of very light blue fabric to each end of the  $2\frac{1}{2}$  x 5 inch teal strip. Make 2 of these strips for each block.

Strip 4



Sew a 2 ½ x 5 inch blueish green strip to each end of the 5 inch medium blue square.

Sew strip 3 to the top and bottom of strip 4 to get one finished block. Make eight of these blocks.

Take 2 of each quilt block and sew them together like this to make one strip.

Strip 5



Make two of these strips. Do the same thing with the remaining quilt blocks so they look like this.

Strip 6



You will have four strips. Sew strip 5 to the top of strip 6. Repeat this step with the other strips that are left. Then sew the remaining pieces together to make the quilt top.

Sew the 3 inch strips of border fabric on vertical sides first then horizontal. Quilt and bind as you would normally.

You could use charm packs to make this quilt. You will need 64 charms (5 inch squares) to make the quilt blocks.
